

# FOS Official State List

## Florida Ornithological Society Records Committee

This is the formal list of modern bird species definitely having occurred in Florida by natural appearance or by establishment of an exotic. The base list shall be the Supplement: Checklist of Florida Birds, pp. 255-260 in Robertson & Woolfenden (1992), as updated by final decisions of the Florida Ornithological Society's Records Committee. The following list of 524 species is updated through 31 December 2016. Established exotics (e); extinct or extirpated native species (x) and disestablished exotics (d); and species listed without verifiable evidence (u) shall be so annotated. Extinct species do not reduce the size of the Florida list, but a disestablished exotic species does. A distinctive member of a subspecies group may be added to the list for review purposes (see below), but it shall not be counted on the list beyond the species' presence there. Species in the list below annotated with an \*(review species list) should be documented when detected in Florida and submitted to the FOSRC for review. In addition, documentation should be submitted to the FOSRC for any species detected in Florida, believed to have occurred naturally or to have escaped, but not appearing in the main list below or in its formatted download versions.
